Format of Play

Form of Play: Two Man, Net Best Ball Match Play, 80% of handicap

Handicaps: All players must have a current WGA Handicap or present the staff with evidence of current scores (6or more) so a handicap may be calculated. In either case it is the Members responsibility to ensure that their guests handicap is accurate. Sandbagging will not be tolerated! We want the competition to be as fair as possible and fun for all.

10 Shot Rule: Partners will only be allowed a 10 shot difference in their 18-hole course handicaps. This translates to a 5 shot difference for the 9-hole matches.

Tees: Players under the age of 65 will play the White Tees. Players 65 and over may play the Gold Tees if they designate it on their entry form. Per WGA rules, there will be an adjustment to the handicaps for those playing the gold tees. Note: Tee designation may not be changed once the flights have been determined.

Flights: Teams will be preflighted into six team flights based on their combined handicaps (the 10 shot rule applies). Each team will play a 9-hole match against the other 5 teams in their flight.

Scoring: Each 9-hole match will be scored on a point per hole basis (ie. 1 point for a win, ½ point for a tie, 0 points for a loss). There will be an additional point for winning a match or in case of a tie, and additional ½ point. (10 points available per match.)

Blowout Rule: The maximum number of points a team can win in any match is limited to 8 points. **Example:** Team A beats Team B (9 to 0). Team A gets a point for winning the match which would make the score (10 to 0). The blowout rule would make the score (8 to 0).

Flight Winners: The winner of each flight will be the team with the highest point total. Ties for flight winners will be determined by 1st - head to head results, 2nd – total matches won, 3rd – a chip off. All flight winners advance to the Championship Shootout.

Wild Card Teams: Two extra teams, not winning their flight, will make the shootout. 1st team will be the team with the highest point total for the 5 matches. 2nd teams will be the team with the highest point total

for Sunday's matches only. **Additionally, any team going undefeated and untied for the five matches will also advance to the shootout.** *Note: Ties for Wild Card Spots will be decided by a closest to the pin challenge from the 10th tee box to the 18th green.*

Championship Shootout: The championship will be decided by a shootout, consisting of all of the flight winners and two or more wild card teams. Beginning immediately following the

final round, the shootout format will be **true alternate shot**. The shootout will begin on Hole #4. The eight (8) lowest scoring teams on Hole #4 will advance to Hole #9. If there are ties at the end of a hole, a chip off will determine which team advances. The three (3) highest scoring teams on Hole #9 will be eliminated and remaining teams will advance to Hole #10. Two (2) teams will be eliminate on Hole #10. The remaining three (3) teams will move on to Hole #17. One team will be eliminated on Hole #17. The two (2) remaining teams will move to Hole #18. Ties will be replayed from the tee box. The winner of Hole #18 becomes the Greene Hill Men's Member Guest Champion !

We invite all players and spouses to join in the fun by following and cheering on our friends and flight competitors during the shootout !

Rules of Play

1. **U.S.G.A. RULES AND THE FOLLOWING APPLY:**
2. **PREFERRED LIES:** A ball lying on the fairway may be lifted and cleaned, without penalty, and placed within **one club length** of where it originally lay, not nearer the hole.
3. **STAKES, FLAGS OR LINES:** WHITE- out of bounds; RED- lateral water hazard; YELLOW- hazard.
4. **GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** Defined with white lines.
5. **PACE OF PLAY:** In order to speed up play, if you are out of the hole, please pick up.
6. **POWER LINES:** Ball striking power poles, lines or guy wires must be replayed without penalty.

7. **LATERAL RELIEF:** May be taken for Out of Bounds and Lost Balls. **Two shot penalty**

8. **OUT OF BOUNDS**

No. 1 - Main highway behind green. Beyond white stakes to right of fairway.

No. 2 - On or across main highway (pavement)

No. 3 - On or across main highway. NOTE! Entrance road is NOT O.B. Play as cart path.

No. 4 - NOTE! Graveyard is NOT O.B.

No. 5 - Beyond white line at clubhouse front & back yards.

No. 7 On or across main highway (hard surface).
Beyond white stakes.

No. 8 - On or across main highway left. Entrance road is NOT O.B. Play as cart path.

No. 9 - On or across entrance road. Beyond white line at clubhouse front & back yards.

No. 11 - Over fence right of fairway.

No. 12 - Ball left of white line. Ball right of white stakes/lines, right of green and fairway

No. 13 - Right of white stakes.

No. 15 - SPECIAL NOTE- Ball in 12th fairway is NOT O.B.

No. 18 Inside fenced area around swimming pool and beyond white line at the clubhouse backyard.

9. **DROP AREAS:**

No. 10 Ball on path or in hazard right of green, use nearest drop circle to take relief. No. 13 Ball in hazard behind the green, take one stroke penalty and drop in nearest drop area

Wagers

Have some fun with this year's field by trying your luck with predicting his year's winners. Here is how it works.

PARAMUTUAL BETTING

Each participant may purchase a \$5.00 ticket on any team in the field, a WIN ticket on teams you feel will finish First Overall in the shootout, a PLACE ticket on the teams you feel will finish First or Second in the shootout, and a SHOW ticket on the teams you feel will finish First, Second

or Third in the shootout. All tickets are \$5.00 per ticket and you may purchase as many tickets as you like in all three categories or you can purchase just one ticket. Payouts are based on the total number of winning tickets in each category divided by the total dollar amount of money within the three category ticket boxes. The winning tickets must match one of the “sister” tickets that will be collected when you purchase the ticket.

SIDE BET

Each team has the opportunity to purchase their team for \$50. The winning team in each flight will receive \$200 and the second (2nd) place team in the flight will receive \$100. If a team decides to not purchase their own team, then any other team may purchase them.

FLIGHT BET

Buying into your own flight (\$50) per team will keep everyone interested in who wins the shootout. If the winning team comes out of your flight, the purse will be split by the number of teams that bought into your flight.

For Example, if every team buys in (60 teams x \$50 = \$3,000), then every team in the winning flight would receive \$500 per team.
